Pray with the Saints of Canada

Saint Marguerite d'Youville (1701-1771)
Saint Marguerite d'Youville was born in 1701 at
Varennes, Quebec. She was married for eight years and
had six children, (four died in infancy and two sons
later became priests) before becoming a widow in
1730. She founded an order of religious women, the
Sisters of Charity, commonly known as the Grey
Nuns. With the Grey Nuns, she established hospitals
in Montreal and across Canada. In 1871 the Grey
Nuns founded the St. Boniface Hospital, located at the
fork of the Red and Assiniboine Rivers. Marguerite
died in 1771 and was canonized in 1990. Her feast is
October 16.

We pray: Dear Saint Marguerite, you are known as Mother of the Poor. You knew and understood poverty from your own life experiences and by caring for those most in need. Within the community, you wanted "perfect union, with one heart and one soul, always considerate and supportive of each other in our weakness, knowing that we need a greater love to bear our own." Intercede for us, so that all Canadian citizens may supportive in working towards making our country free of poverty by always being truly in perfect union. Amen.
