Defending the rights of poor communities fractured by forced evictions in Nigeria

In Nigeria, forced evictions are carried out violently, without consulting those concerned, as well as without warning, compensation, or providing alternative housing.

Thanks to your support, the Social and Economic Rights Action Centre (SERAC), a Development and Peace partner, has worked for over 20 years with slum communities in Lagos to promote and protect the socioeconomic rights of inhabitants, including their rights to adequate housing/shelter, livelihood, water, food, access to electricity and education.
