Some individuals have reported having received fake emails requesting money, purporting to be from members of the clergy of the Diocese of Peterborough. Such emails are a scam. All official emails from clergy of the Diocese of Peterborough will come from email addresses ending with "@peterboroughdiocese.org" or an official parish email address like "@stthomasmillbrook.ca". At this time, neither our parish nor our diocese ever requests money via email. *In 1633 the people of Oberammergau suffered from the plague. The surviving villagers prayed that their families would be spared, vowing, should their prayers be answered, to perform a Passion Play every ten years. Their prayers were heard as not a single person in the village fell victim to the Plague after that. Keeping their promise, the people of Oberammergau performed the first play in 1634 and have continued to do so every decade since.*
