MORE FROM YOUR PRIEST:

LENT: It is the time of the year that we remember the highest sacrifice that the Son of God offered to humanity; his Passion and Death on the cross. He said, "No greater love than this, that a person lays down one's life for a friend." Let us not forget that death was not the end of Jesus' life, but after three days he rose from the dead to fulfill his promise that after suffering, and dying on the third day he will rise again. This is what we call the Paschal mystery, suffering, dying and rising again, the central point of our faith.

During Lent the church is asking members to journey with the Messiah, by participating in some kind of Lenten sacrifice of fasting and abstinence. There are two days of fasting and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Fridays in lent are considered days of abstinence. The difference lies in, fasting is cutting down our food intake for the day while abstinence is to abstain from meat. But we can extend the idea of fasting and abstinence to other things like denying oneself from things of pleasure and ease, i.e. from excessive use of TV, indulgence to sweets, alcohol, or gambling and going another mile in the spiritual aspect of life such as attending weekday masses, more prayer time, scriptural readings and participating in some Lenten devotions like stations of the cross and others. Let us try to do some spiritual nourishment this Lent, so that we will be ready to renew our baptismal promises during the Easter vigil.

May we all have a blessed and spirit-filled Lent.
