FR. ADTODIO BAROL'S MESSAGE FOR SUDDAY — DECEMBER 11TH, 2022

Dear sisters/brothers, parishioners of St. Thomas More and St. Bernadette,

The mass entrance antiphon, "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed the Lord is near." Today is Gaudete Sunday and the message of rejoicing should echo in the world that we have to rejoice and be glad for the Messiah is near. Once again Prophet Isaiah tried to give hope to the people who walked in darkness in their exile, that there is hope and that there will be peace amidst their experience of chaos in the land of exile. He said, "And the ransom of the Lord shall return, and come to Zion with singing; everlasting joy shall be upon their heads."

What we need while we wait is the virtue of patience, as St. James said in the second reading, "Be patient brothers and sisters, until the coming of the Lord. The farmer waits for the precious crop from the earth, being patient with it until it receives the early and late rains." In this busy time of the year, it is easy to get impatient especially in waiting, like when you go to the grocery store, or going to a doctor's appointment and could also be with our spiritual activities like people would like the mass to be just 30 minutes, or just pray fast and quick. In this Advent season let us try to develop the virtue of patience and let us try to spend more time in prayer as the Lord is near at hand and one of the reasons why we do not experience joy is because we do not have the patience of waiting. If we look around, we live in an instant world, we do not have the patience of waiting. This Christmas let us ask the Lord to teach us the joy of waiting and that prayer is the best thing we can do while we wait.

The gospel of St. Matthew is telling us about the two cousins, John the Baptist and Jesus. Tired of waiting for the Messiah, the people tried to focus their attention to John as the Messiah so they came to him to be baptized but John knew that he was not the Messiah but only a person who will prepare the coming of the Messiah. He was imprisoned for speaking against the evils of the world especially about King Herod's unlawful relationship with his brother's wife. Knowing that he was not the Messiah he had to send delegates to ask about Jesus.

Jesus showed the followers of John his works and words about the restoration of the lost glory of creation; "Go and tell John what you hear and see; the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them." To clarify matters Jesus also said about John, "Truly I tell you, among those born of women no one has arisen greater than John the Baptist; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he." We know that St. Matthew was very focus on the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophecies as being fulfilled in Jesus.

As we come near the celebration of the first coming which we call Christmas, let us not forget the second aspect of Advent which is to prepare for the second coming of Christ, so that with joyful hearts we celebrate the first coming and also anticipate his second coming.
