FR. TODY'S MESSAGE FOR THIS LIEEK

Dear sisters/brothers; parishioners of St. Thomas More and St. Bernadette,

Our Readings for the 4^{TH} Sunday in Lent – B.

First Readings: 2 Chronicles 36. 14-17a, 19-23++; "The Israelites were repeatedly unfaithful to God. They ignored the prophets sent to them. God allowed them to fall to the Chaldeans, which Jeremiah had foretold."

Psalm Response: "Let my tongue cling to my mouth if I do not remember you.""

Second Reading: Ephesians 2. 4-10; "God's mercy and love brought Jesus into the world. Salvation is God's gift, not our human work, Jesus leads all people to perform good works."

Gospel: John 3. 14-21;"Jesus is to die on the cross, the proof of God's unlimited love for us. God sent Jesus that all people might believe. Through belief in him we will be saved."

Every Friday in Lent the mass will be at 5:00 PM in the church followed by the Stations of the Cross. Please, let us join in this beautiful devotion of journeying with Jesus in his suffering and dying to save the world. Plenary indulgence is attached to this Lenten devotion. Indulgence originally meant kindness or favor, in post-classic Latin it came to mean the remission of a tax or debt and in a special sense it is a remission of the temporal punishment due to sin, the guilt of which has been forgiven.

Please, plan to attend the city wide Lenten Mission at the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains in Peterborough, from March 11, 12 and 13. There will be two of the same session one at 11:00PM and at 7:00PM. Those who have bigger rides and please, offer a ride to others especially those who find it hard to drive to the city. A sign up sheet is found at the entrance of the church. There might be also confessions after the sessions. The Cathedral is also offering a whole day confessions on Saturday the 16th of March from 9:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Every Friday before the 5:00 PM mass confession is available from 4:00 PM.

Please, do not forget the Development and Peace collection on the weekend of March 16 and 17. The Chrism Mass this year is moved to 2:00 PM instead of 7:00 PM to give chance to people from outside the city to come celebrate and witness the blessings of the Holy Oils, and the Priest's renewal of their ordination promises.

Our parish needs you to be part of the different Church ministries, therefore please, make yourself available that together we can make our parish grow in Faith, Hope and Charity.

We need volunteers to reach out to our home-bound sisters and brothers in our nursing and senior homes.

I have written a letter to some men of the parish to act as disciples for the washing of the feet on <u>Holy Thursday</u>, when we celebrate the Last Supper, the Institution of the Holy Eucharist and also the Institution of the Sacrament of Holy Order.
