FR. TODY'S MESSAGE FOR THIS LIEEK

Dear sisters/brothers; parishioners of St. Thomas More and St. Bernadette,

Our Readings for the 5^{TH} Sunday in Lent – B.

First Readings: Jeremiah 31.31-34; "The Lord promises a new covenant in which God's law will be written in people's heart."

Psalm Response: "Create in me, create in me a clean heart, O God.".

Second Reading: "Hebrew 5. 7-9; "We recall how Jesus prayed to his Father. Through obedience to suffering, Jesus became perfect and is the source of salvation for all who obey him."

Gospel: John 12. 20-33; "Jesus predicts his glorification. It comes by dying like the grain of wheat. Those who love their life lose it. The Father from heaven answers Jesus."

Every Friday in Lent the mass will be at 5:00 PM in the church followed by the Stations of the Cross. Please, let us join in this beautiful devotion of journeying with Jesus in his suffering and dying to save the world. Plenary indulgence is attached to this Lenten devotion. Indulgence originally meant kindness or favor, in post-classic Latin it came to mean the remission of a tax or debt and in a special sense it is a remission of the temporal punishment due to sin, the guilt of which has been forgiven.

A special mass will be celebrated this Tuesday March 19, for the Solemnity of Saint Joseph; Principal Patron of Canada and the Universal Patron of the Church. Mass will be in the chapel at 5:00 PM.

The Chrism Mass on March 25th is moved to 2:00 PM instead of 7:00 PM to give chance to people from outside the city to come celebrate and witness the blessings of the Holy Oils, and the Priest's renewal of their ordination promises. Please, let us support our priests by our attendance.

The Cathedral is also offering a whole day confessions on Saturday the 16th of March from 9:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Every Friday before the 5:00 PM mass confession is available from 4:00 PM.

April 17 – Feast of the Divine Mercy, besides the Sunday masses, there is a 3:00 PM – celebration of the Divine Mercy. Starts with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, chanting of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, a short reflection by Fr. Ace, the Rosary and the Benediction. After the celebration there will be a little refreshment in the hall and we welcome guests from other parishes who want to join our Divine Mercy celebration. Please, come and experience this powerful devotion started by Saint Faustina Kowalska
