

FR. TODY'S MESSAGE FOR THIS WEEK

Dear sisters/brothers; parishioners of St. Thomas More and St. Bernadette,

Theme: "The theme of the shepherd unifies Scripture and reveals God's loving concern for us."

The Readings:

First Reading: Acts 5: 27-32, 40-41; "With strong faith the Apostles persevere in the mission that Christ gave them."

Psalm Response: "I will extol you Lord, for you have raised me up."

Second Reading: Revelation: 5: 11-14; "The power and the glory of God are acclaimed by all creation."

Gospel: John 21: 1-19; "Again the risen Savior appears to the disciples in a very human way. Peter in three affirmations rejects his triple denial and again hears the call, "Follow me."

The generosity of your time, talent and treasure are indeed a blessing to our parish and to any priest in the present and in the future. May God shower you with his blessings of good health and good things in your life.

The National March for Life will be held this Thursday, May 8, at the Parliament Hill in Ottawa. I was planning to go but when I was writing this bulletin I noticed that I have a scheduled mass at the Centennial Place and the residents always look forward to the mass. Now I found a solution that even if we cannot be there let us be with them in our prayers. At 12:00 noon on Thursday let us pray a community rosary in the rectory. A coffee, tea and some goodies will be available. Please come and join the rally by our prayer. Thank you.

May 10 at 7:00PM at St. Alphonsus Church the "Misfits" will be back featuring Fr. Paul Massel and Danny Bronson. Come and have a fun time singing along with the old classics. It is a free will offering.

The Northern Deanery pilgrim church of St. Patrick in Kearney in the month of May until October will be open from 9:00AM to 5:00PM. From July 1 to 15, they have a special schedule from Monday to Friday; 10AM is Holy Hour and Confession and 11AM mass. The Jubilee mass will be on the 16th the feast of our Lady of Mount Carmel, the mass will be at 11:00 AM with Bishop Miehm as the main celebrant.

Another diocesan pilgrimage is planned also to culminate the year of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in Trout Creek on June 27. The celebration will start with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the morning with silent adoration and confession is available to those who want it and the mass will be at 3:30 PM with Bishop Miehm as the main celebrant.

The diocese of Peterborough is also planning for a diocesan wide pilgrimage to the Martyr's Shrine in Midland on September 20, 2025.

If you want a quiet day off from your daily chores and spend time in prayer and contemplation, Mount St. Joseph's Sisters has a place for you from Monday to Friday, from 9:00 AM to 4:00PM with a mass at 11:15 AM if you like to join with the sister's community. You are to draw your own schedule for the day.

To visit a shrine is also suggested and what are these? Shrines are erected either to protect relics or to commemorate the presence of God in a particular place at a particular time. The Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy says that they can also have a deep significance as 'signs of cosmic harmony and reflections of divine beauty because of their physical positioning" (paragraph 263). Some are placed over the grave of a saint, while others, like the Oratory of St. Joseph in Montreal, are built on the faith of a visionary. These can be privileged places to ask for God's help or to give thank for favours received. They are often the object of pilgrimage.
