The 3rd Sunday of Easter Year A encourages to look for Jesus among the living. The readings show how His followers came to believe in the resurrection. They also call us to live with hope and trust in His promise. In the first reading, Peter tells the crowd that Jesus' death and resurrection were part of God's plan. He speaks with courage, showing that the Holy Spirit gives strength to share the Good News. The Gospel shares the story of the road to Emmaus. Two disciples walk with a stranger who explains the Scriptures to them. They invited him to spend a night with them. At table through the breaking of the bread, they recognized Jesus.
